# Penicuik Open Exhibition and Penicuik Turner Prize.

26<sup>th</sup> September till 4<sup>th</sup> October 2020

## Summary

### Important Dates and Times

Jpeg images of works will be accepted up until noon on Thursday the 24<sup>th</sup> September.

The exhibition will be available to view on line from 10.00am and Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup> September and will remain on line till noon on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> November

Penicuik Turner Prize will be judged by Jemma Derbyshire and will be announced at the close of her lecture on Wednesday the 30<sup>th</sup> September

### Displaying conditions

All works should be presented as a jpeg image.

The works should correspond to works on the entry for

Everybody allowed 3 entries. Because the exhibition is on line there are no restrictions regarding size.

ENTRY FEE OF £3 per work for non-members. £2 for members

### Commission

PCAA charges commission on all sales: 25% of sale price for non-members and 15% of sale price for members. Bear this in mind when pricing work

### Sale of Works.

All works to be sold through PCAA. Commission will be deducted and the remainder will be paid to the artist within 4 weeks of the sale. It is the responsibility of the artist to contact the purchaser and arrange to hand over the art work.

## 2. Prizes

All exhibits are considered for two prizes:

### **The Penicuik Turner Prize judged by Jemma Derbyshire**

The trophy for this prize was designed, made and donated by local blacksmith Andrew Turner (hence the name). The winning entry is chosen by a judge who is usually a visual artist. This year the competition will be judged by Jemma Derbyshire an artist based in Portobello who has a particular interest in colour. Previously a landscape artist she is now increasingly painting still lifes. Jemma will be presenting a lecture about her works and inspirations on Wednesday the 30<sup>th</sup> September via ZOOM. Jemma will announce the winner of the Turner Prize at the close of the lecture.

We hope you will be able to join us for this meeting.

### **The People's Choice Trophy**

In 2016 the People's Choice Trophy was introduced. Visitors to the exhibition are invited to vote for their favourite work. The trophy is awarded to the artist whose art work wins the popular vote. The trophy was designed by Jan Miller and donated by Penicuik Arts Association.

Voting on line for the People's Choice will run from the opening of the exhibition on Saturday the 30<sup>th</sup> September till noon on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> October. The winner will be posted on the website as soon as the votes have been counted.

## 3. Application deadline

Works should be registered using the entry form and jpeg images of the work should be sent to [jmcdonaldjimm@aol.com](mailto:jmcdonaldjimm@aol.com) by noon on Thursday the 26<sup>th</sup> September.

## 4. Conditions of entry.

All work not previously shown at PCCA is eligible for entry.

All entries should be matched to a completed entry form and payment of hanging fees.

Please note it is important to complete all fields in the entry form to ensure that we can contact you if you have won either of the trophies, if a work has been sold and if a member of the public would like more

information about the artist or the works. We will not pass on any of your contact details. But will use them to contact you directly.

Up to 3 art works may be submitted by each person.

Hanging fee is £3per item (£2 for PCAA member)

## 6 Sale of works

PCAA takes commission of 25%of the sale price from non-members and 15% from members of the Association.

Please take this into account when you are pricing works.

The purchase price should be entered on entry form. If no price is entered the works will be displayed as NFS (Not For Sale). We encourage artists to offer art works for sale but it is not a requirement.

## 12. Membership of the PCAA

Membership of the PCAA is very reasonably priced and has many benefits. As you will note from the above, it reduces costs for exhibiting. It also gives a discount for most of the events in the Arts Centre – generally £2 reduction in ticket price. You will receive a regular newsletter with details of everything that is happening in the centre.

Membership is paid annually and is £15 standard rate and £10 for unwaged. Membership application forms will be available when you hand in your art works.
